## FEED THE FRY TOURNAMENT

**May 14, 2011 (Blow date May 15<sup>th</sup>) - 6:00am - 2:00pm - Port Dalhousie  
St Catharines Game & Fish Boat Ramp**

**\$75 per Team/Maximum 6 rods**

Pay/register at the ramp on the morning of the tournament between 4:30 and 5.45 AM

*Total Weight of Three Salmon (Chinook or Coho)  
24" Minimum size*

### ***Strait Line Anglers Club of Grimsby***

**50% Cash Payout and percentage based on number of boats (see payout structure table) Less than ten boats-winner takes all.**

**35% to the Port Dalhousie Pen Imprinting Project,**

**15% to the Strait Line Anglers Club**

- 1.) Must follow all Ontario Ministry of Natural Resources Regulations and Restricted Areas.
- 2.) Must pay tournament organizer in full at the boat ramp before morning blast off. No Registrations accepted after 5:45 am.
- 3.) Boat Checks will be random, but you must come to the St Catharines Game and Fish Boat Ramp to be made available to arrange a boat check. Boats coming from other ports must first stop at registration table to register and have the boat made available for boat checks.
- 4.) Blast off is done at 6:00 am sharp by VHF and air horn. All contestants boats must blast off from in front of Port Dalhousie. No additional departure areas from other ports are allowed.
- 5.) Maximum of 6 rods can be used at one time. Number of people on board is up to the discretion of the captain. The moneys will only be addressed to the captain.
- 6.) Return time is marked when the boat number "Puck" is dropped into the net of the tournament official standing at the base of the Light House in the channel of Port Dalhousie (East side wall). 1 lbs per minute will be the penalty of up to a maximum of 15minutes/lbs before

disqualification. The Tournament Official will leave and no longer accept pucks at 2:15 pm sharp.

7.) All Tournament Contestants leaving early or not returning to port must call in to St Catharines Game and Fish Ramp to identify yourself as being safely off the water but without dropping off the puck. Indicate your boat number and returning port name. (905) 937-6335

8.) Winner is determined by the total weight of three salmon Minimum 24" Total Length (tail fin squished down for maximum length).

9.) The three fish to weigh together must be identified before going on the scales. The biggest fish of the three must be identified with electrical tie before coming to the scale.

10.) Decision made by judges, tournament director and tournament officials are final and not subject to appeal.

11.) It's a Big Lake-Share it!
